

Program memberships are available for those who wish to participate in YMCA of Arlington programs only. Individual Program memberships are \$25/year or \$40/year for family plus the registration fee. Non-YMCA members must register for program membership before registering for swim classes.

- 5. Choose a session(s). Lastly, click the "Register" button.
