Grounds Committee Update Dianne del Cid



ELE Entrances

Falcon Lake Entrance has undergone some renovation and additional plantings. The Neitzel family has graciously offered water for the new plantings. Thank you so much Neitzels!

The Lake Mead entrance water pooling and grading problem was repaired in early January by the City of Arlington Public Works. Runoff water now drains into the channel to the North. This repair came just in time for the icy weather in February.

Seasonal color for Spring/summer is now under consideration and will be installed at the entrance and the clubhouse beds by the time you read this newsletter.

Common Grounds and Clubhouse

The clubhouse front entrance beds have been renovated with installation of ground cover in place of the struggling grass under the trees. The containers have been irrigated so whatever is planted will have consistent watering.

Estimates are being requested for repairing the articulated concrete wall behind the Tennis Court that was damaged during last year's heavy rains. There has been discussion at recent board meetings concerning the issue of the eroding canals. A special committee will be formed to look into the legal ramifications of any future restoration to the area along the canal from Shorewood to the pool. In the meantime, the City of Arlington Water Department has been testing the water for any possible waste contamination and so far, the reports have been clean. The city has been aerating and adding de-chlorinated water into the canal to help with the smell that seems to invade the area every spring.

Finally, a row of Hollies was added along the fence line of the common area that parallels the road to the Lake Arlington boat ramp and park at Poly Webb. Temporary irrigation was installed with the contribution of a hook-up with the Puckett's irrigation system. A big ELE thanks to Linda and Hal Puckett for their collaboration.
