In preparation for summer, the board has undertaken several improvement and maintenance projects to maintain our neighborhood assets. In addition to the tennis court resurfacing, Gene Gehring, has overseen the installation of a French drain and berm construction along the west side of the tennis courts. This should alleviate the sub-surface water flow that was creating a lot of wear and tear on the courts.

The clubhouse and pool area has received a lot of electrical repair that corrected some potential safety hazards, including an newly updated main breaker box. John Nohinek, our pool committee chair, has been busy, hiring guards and performing all sorts of tasks to get the pool in order. Unfortunately, our plans to resurface the southern end of the wearing pool deck were foiled by a non-performing contractor, who promised to have the job done before Splash Day and backed-out a week before opening. John is looking for a more reliable source, and will arrange to have the repair done after the pool closes, so it will be ready for next season.

Tracy Bush, our social chair, is planning another great event for the Independence Day celebration. If you're in town over the fourth, come down to the boat ramp in the evening. We'll be grilling hotdogs and watching fireworks. Watch the entrance signs for details.

Social Committee Update

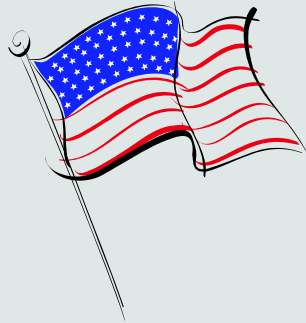
The neighborhood is having a party!
