

Dental Hygiene 100 years

Proud Past & Unlimited Future

This year, 2013 is the 100th year of the profession of Dental Hygiene. It has been an exciting and enlightening year as celebrations continue all across the United States.





Bridgeport, Connecticut. Only women were allowed to enroll in the school and attend classes in the evening in the reception area of the carriage house where Fones practiced dentistry. In November of 1914, twenty-seven (27) graduated. By 1923, the profession had expanded and the American Dental Hygienists' Association (ADHA) was created in order to organize efforts. As the years have gone by, the requirements for entering a dental hygiene program have gone from 1 year past 8th grade to a minimum of a high school diploma and in most cases, college level pre-requisite courses. In 1952, all states began to license dental hygienists and the accreditation process for dental hygiene programs began. In 1986 the American Dental Hygienists' Association adopted a policy advocating for a bachelor's degree as the minimum degree for entry into the dental hygiene profession. There are still many excellent associate degree programs throughout the country but now, along with bachelor and master's degree programs. The profession has certainly come a long way!

This year, the American Dental Hygienists' Association Center for Lifelong Learning (ADHA CLL), which is the national annual session, celebrated 100 years of the profession in Boston, Massachusetts which is "just down the road" from Bridgeport, Connecticut where it all began in 1913. There were more than 3000 hygienists in attendance from all across the country. 146 were from District IX (which includes Texas, New Mexico and Oklahoma). 104 were from Texas. It was so exciting to see how Boston embraced hygienists with banners in the hotel and along the streets of downtown. There was something going on for everyone at all times - from informative Continuing Education Courses, to top of the line exhibitors, to business meetings and lots of networking.

So, to sum it all up...there are now more than 150,000 Dental Hygienists nationwide comprised of both men and women with educations ranging from an associate's degree to a master's degree. This organized group of professionals has gone from a carriage house reception room to college degrees – all in 100 years!
