Grounds

Just a reminder to check your exterior fence and any landscaping that may hide it from view. For residents on Big Bear Lake Drive, take a walk behind your property and see if there are any low hanging limbs that could obstruct the sidewalk. Remember, there must be a minimum eight-foot (8') clearance for safe passage. We don't want Code Enforcement to come knocking at your door.

If you are planning any work that requires pre-approval, please complete the Architectural Improvement form, attach any required documentation, plans, drawings, etc. and arrange for the forms to be dropped off for approval. The Architecture Committee will review the approval request in a timely manner so work can start as soon as possible.

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Crime Prevention Update

As we mentioned in our recent neighborhood email, ELE unfortunately has experienced some break-ins recently. We want our neighborhood to remain the safe, family-friendly environment that attracts and maintains so many wonderful families. Following are the security suggestions mentioned in the previous neighborhood email along with some additional ideas:

- If you see any suspicious activity, please call 911;
- Install and use a security system and consider using cameras too;
- Purchase and install a \$20.00 brace from Lowe's or Home Depot to put under your front doorknob to reinforce the door and make it harder for someone to kick in the door;
- Reinforce the bolts and panel on your front door (i.e. replace the small screws with longer bolts and the wood paneling with metal plates);
- Install a storm door (authorities have suggested a storm door is a deterrent to burglars);
- Join NextDoor as the neighborhood is working together to keep each other apprised of situations like these to prevent further break-ins in ELE;
 - The ELE site on Nextdoor.com is private. Only residents within our neighborhood boundaries can join our site. You may also participate on the broader "Lake Arlington" site. That includes all of the neighborhoods near ELE, and it is a good source of information as well:
 - Nextdoor.com is recommended and used extensively by the Arlington Police Department.
 The crime prevention team posts regularly on the site, and they are counting on us to post information they can use to help solve crimes;
 - Please tell your ELE neighbors about the site, and invite them to join. We want as much participation as possible. If you have any questions about Nextdoor.com, please call Lisa Sawyer at 817-271-1059;
- Ensure that all vehicles belonging to your house have an Enchanted Lake Estates decal please contact Lisa Sawyer at 817-271-1059 if you are new to the neighborhood or need
 additional decals for your vehicles;
- Get to know your neighbors and be familiar with the types of vehicles they drive, whether
 they are expecting out of town guests, or will be having hired services performed at their
 homes do not be afraid to contact a neighbor if you are concerned about activity you see at
 their house!
- Never open your door to anyone you don't know;
- Trim shrubbery that hides the doors and windows of your house;
- Illuminate your yards and entranceways and consider using motion detection lighting;
- Keep your doors locked whether you are at home or away;
- Keep your garage door closed and locked, even when at home or in the backyard;
- Lock your vehicle if it is not in your garage and never leave valuables in a vehicle in view;
- Half of all home burglaries occur during the day so be alert to any suspicious persons or vehicles in the area. If anything seems out of place, notify the police to check it out;

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- Be observant of repair personnel, construction workers, or service workers who might be thieves. If their behavior or location seems out of the ordinary, notify police.
- Take a look around your house and prepare yourself in the unlikely event you are a victim. Take photos of your property for insurance and recovery purposes. Back up your computer files. Download photos from your cameras. Store your backup in a safe location, possibly away from your home. Insurance can replace your devices, but not precious photos and documents.

This list may look long, but these are just simple steps and suggestions that we hope will help keep you and our neighborhood safe! We are looking forward to a fun-filled, exciting summer here at ELE!
