### New Recipe:

Looking for a new cake recipe? Here is an easy and delicious twist to the lemon pound cake:

#### Lemon Apricot Pound Cake:

- 1 yellow cake mix
- 1 sugar-free pkg lemon gelatin
- 4 eggs
- 3/4 c. oil
- 3/4 c. apricot nectar
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 tsp lemon extract

Combine all ingredients and mix for about two minutes. Pour into a prepared bundt cake pan and bake at 350 degrees for 40-45 minutes until done.

#### Lemon Glaze:

Juice of one lemon  
1 cup powdered sugar  
Combine lemon juice and sugar and mix well. Drizzle over hot bundt cake. Cool before serving.
